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#### **ABSTRACT**

Portfolio management and its performance on profit is major objective of development banks in Nepal. The research focuses towards identifying contribution of Portfolio management through attracting investors on healthy business area. Efficiency of investment by Nepalese development banks is measured in this study. Descriptive and analytical research design is used for carrying out the results. Acceptance of deposits is the primary function of banks.
