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ABSTRACT

The present research study entitled An Analysis of Course of ELT Curriculum, Materials and Management aims to find out the strengths and weaknesses of the course of ELT Curriculum, Materials and Management prescribed for the second year master of education. I have analyzed the course on the basis of strengths and weaknesses with special reference to the present context of English language education in Nepal. This research study attempts to incite the language learners to design, plan, improve, and develop the ELT courses and many other secondary sources of data to find out how to make the course more effective, qualitative and practical. To meet the objectives of this research, I have collected required information by studying deeply of the course of ELT Curriculum, Materials and Management used as the primary sources of data. For this purpose, I adopted a qualitative research on abovementioned data, selecting the course of ELT Curriculum, Materials and Management and collected required information.
