ABSTRACT

Broadly speaking poverty includes the deficiency in the field of food, clothing, health facility, sanitation, land holding, condition of houses, education and so on. In Bhalam V.D.C of Kaski district, Gandaki Zone, Nepal, poverty is mainly concentrated to the weakness in income sources, scarcity of cultivable land, road facility and the concept of the people living there. People are mostly satisfied with what they have acquired from their ancestors. There is negligible progress in the earning in comparision is the condition people were a few decades before.
