## ABSTRACT

This study entitled "Analysis of the Language Used on Online Chatting" aims to analyze the language used on online chatting and email in terms of linguistic, functional and sign system, code switching related features of the language. The researcher used purposive non random sampling method and collected data from 40 students and analyzed those data using simple statistical tools. The chief finding of the research was that the students used grammatically and functionally ill formed expressions of English language on online chatting such as most of the students used shortening and abbreviate form of words on their use of English language on online chatting.
