## ABSTRACT

The study entitled **Effectiveness of Newspaper Cut-outs in Developing Writing Skill** mainly focused on teaching, writing with the help of newspaper cut-outs. For this study, the researcher took sample consisting of thirty students of Nalanda Secondary Boarding School, Satdobato, Lalitpur. The study was based on primary source of data. The population of the study was sampled through random sampling procedure. Test items were the main tools for the data collection by taking pre-test and post-test. The collected data were coded on the basis of analysis and interpretation. The researcher came to the conclusion that using teaching materials while teaching writing skill has a significant role to enhance the students' writing. Moreover, students were found motivated and actively participated in the classroom.

The whole thesis is divided into five chapters: The first chapter deals with the background of the study, statement of the problem, rational of the study, objectives of the study, significance, delimitations and operational definition of key terms.
