#### **ABSTRACT**

This research work attempts to compare the reading comprehension ability of the Eighth Graders of Sunsari district in a variety of seen and unseen texts. To carry out this research work, the researcher prepared test items including six different seen and unseen texts i.e. story, letter and biography. Then a test was administered to a number of 60 students in order to find out data for the research. The sources of data were 60 students from different six public schools of Sunsari. (i.e. Eighth Graders only). Then the test was administered to collect the data. After the administration of the test, the answer sheets of the students were collected, analysed and the reading comprehension ability was compared.

This research study consists of five chapters. Introduction, Review of Related
Literature and Conceptual Frame Work, Methodology, Results and Discussion and
Findings and Recommendations. The first chapter Introduction contains General
Background, Statement of the Problem, Rationale of the Study, Objectives, Research
