Abstract

"Hawkers and their Impacts on the Tourism of Thamel" is a thesis focused on the hawkers or street vendors and their impacts on the tourism particularly based on Thamel area. This dissertation writing has tried to answer the issues of hawkers, their identification, their situation, impacts on the tourism due to their behaviours and management framework through the analytical approach.
