#### **Abstract**

Ritual performance is one of the oldest forms of socio-cultural practices persistent in most societies, around the world. Humans in almost all the societies have adhered to some specific way of living, which has been a part of their life. Continuous practice of certain behavior followed by offerings gives rise to culture and custom which in turn becomes a ritual – a way of life for the people.
