Abstract

Dracula is often considered as a gothic novel. Its main character, Dracula is undoubtedly a vampire as the prey on living human beings. While considering the novel association with the disruption and transgression the novel bears the undertones of sexual perversion. There are a number of incidents in the novel that show Dracula's vampiric procreation.
