ABSTRACT

The present study **PROSPECTS AND CONSTRAINTS OF RELIGIONS IN NEPAL:** A Case Study of Dakshainkali Temple, Ward no. 5 Dakshainakali Municipality
also a remote village. The specific objectives of to analyze the level of infrastructure
development in Dakshainlali, to compare social, economic and environmental impact of
religious tourism and to explore the challenges of tourism development in the study area.

The selection of the study area is one of the critical issues while undertaking a research work. Considering the common base in site selection Dakshainkali Temple is selected to cover the reflection of the maximum area of Kathmandu district as a place of attraction for the village tourism in the field of ecotourism, cultural tourism, rural tourism, agro-tourism and religious tourism.

Because of poverty, they are finding hardship to maintain hand to mouth problem. Before this study there are no any studies in this subject which shows actual situation of possibilities of village tourism.
