## **Abstract**

Chinua Achebe's *Anthill of the Savannah* critiques the colonial effects launched by the British rulers and their African agents. So, this study explores the issue of resistance. Chinua Achebe uses the non-western elements and resists the white domination. The text shows the colonial implication even after the colonization and rejection.
