#### **ABSTRACT**

The present study entitled **Application of Progress Test in Developing Writing Skill** was carried out with the aim to identify and compare the students' progress based on age and gender. I carried out my research using non-random purposive sampling procedure. A set of questionnaire was prepared as a research tool for the elicitation of the required information and so the informants of Dailekh District were taken as the sample for the study. The major finding of the research was that diagnostic test had a better effect in developing writing skill to the students of the English language.

This thesis has been divided into four chapters. The first chapter deals with general background, linguistic scenario of ELT in Nepal, testing in language teaching, types of testing, need of tests, a short note on measurement, test and evaluation, and relationship between teaching and testing. It also includes review of literature, objectives and significance of the study. The second chapter is concerned with the methodology used in the study. It includes sources of data, population of the study, sampling procedure, research tools, process of data collection and limitations of the study.
