#### ABSTRACT

The present study entitled "Difficulties in Reading Comprehension" was carried out with the aim to find out the problem faced by secondary level students in reading comprehension and causes of students' poor reading comprehension. In order to fulfil the objectives of the study, 60 secondary level students and 20 English teachers of the same level were selected from the 20 schools of the Kaski district through purposive sampling procedure. Two sets of questionnaire were the research tools for eliciting the required information for the study. The data collected were analyzed and interpreted to find out difficulties in reading comprehension and its causes. It was found that the secondary level students of Kaski district had major difficulty to understand the meaning of vocabulary items in reading comprehension. They also faced the problem of language structure. The main causes behind this was lack of persistency and motivation.

This thesis is organized in four chapters. The first chapter deals with general background, importance of reading, reading comprehension, types of reading, techniques of teaching reading comprehension, stages in teaching reading comprehension, review of the related literature, objectives and significance of study. The second chapter is concerned with the methodology used in the study, under which sources of data, sampling procedure, tools for data collection, process of data collection and limitations of the study are described. The third chapter deals with analysis and interpretation of data. This chapter consists of two sub-sections. The first sub-section deals with analysis of questionnaire to the students. The second sub-section deals with the analysis of questionnaire to the teachers. The final chapter deals with the major findings and recommendations of the study.
