#### **ABSTRACT**

This research work entitled 'Cyberculture in Literature: A Reflection of Nepali Fictions' has been carried out to analyze the use of cyberculture in the selected Nepali fictions and to show its use in ELT with the different tools of cyberculture technology. It is the analytical survey in the present day world. For this, I purposively selected four different Nepali fictions having English translation viz.
