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STATUS OF WOMEN IN RAUTAHAT DISTRICT

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ABSTRACT

This study has mainly focused on the status of women in terms of empowerment in mobility, participation in household decision making and nutrition. This study is based on the secondary source of data taken from PAF Monitoring and Evaluation Survey. The study has covered 930 households of the 41 rural areas of Rautahat District and the whole analysis is based on Caste/ethnicity.

This study has tried to explain the empowerment status of women in terms of mobility. It was found that most of the women (64%) can visit the places like maternal home, local market and religious institutions alone but only few of them can do without the permission of household head. It has found that empowerment status of Muslim women is poor than others. Terai Dalit and Muslim women have poor nutritional status in comparison of others.

Participation of women in terms of decision-making in household is better than that of mobility status. Almost 82 percent of women responded that they were participated in decision-making process of household properties. Terai Janjati women were comparatively poor condition than others in terms of control over household income.

To expose the nutritional status of women aged 15-49, all the women of surveyed households of those ages were measured by taking height and weight. It was found that Terai Dalits and Muslims were nutritionally weak than other cast/ethnic groups. Only about 61 percent Muslim have normal BMI, which is lower than the rest groups.
