ABSTRACT

The present study entitled "Verbal Affixation in English and Baitadeli" aims at finding out to identify verbal affixes in Baitadeli dialect, to point out similarities and differences in the verbal affixation of English and Baitadeli and to suggest some pedagogical implications on the basis of findings of the study. To carry out the research work, the researcher collected the data distributing the questionnaires to eighty native speakers of Baitadeli from two VDCs; Ganjari and Shibaling of, Baitadi district by using judgmental non-random sampling procedure. The study showed that both English and Baitadeli have the verbal affixation systems. Both languages have only verbal suffixes not prefixes and infixes, but both have only one verbal prefix i.e. *not* in English and -n i in Baitadeli. English has less verbal suffixes than that of Baitadeli. In English /- ing / is only the continuous suffix for verb but Baitadeli has /-1 r/, /-1 rek/ are continuous suffixes for the verb.

This study contains four chapters. Chapter one includes general background, review of the related literature, objectives of the study and significance of the study. Chapter two deals with methodology adopted in carrying out the research. It contains the sources of data, population of the study, sampling procedure, tools and process of data collection, limitation of the study. Chapter three consists of the analysis and interpretation of the data. The data was collected through the questionnaire and analyzed. The parallel interpretation between English and Baitadeli was done in this chapter. Chapter four incorporates the major findings of the study on the basis of analysis and interpretation of the data. It also deals with some recommendations made on the basis of findings of the study.
