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ABSTRACT

The purpose of the present study was to pinpoint whether the vocabularies given in the textbook are sufficient to meet the objectives set in the curriculum and to analyze the textbook in term of *word use, word meaning, word formation* and *difficulty level*. The researcher selected five B.Ed. campuses in the Janakpur zone purposively. He selected 60 students for B.Ed. second year major English, in which 12 students were selected from each campus. The researcher used two sets of questionnaire. A test was taken from the students and a set of closed ended questionnaire for teachers. The researcher visited selected campuses, established rapport and got the students collected with the help of the English teachers. He administered the test to the selected students and a questionnaire to the teachers and then he collected them. The data collected from the respondents were analyzed and interpreted and found that the textbook is good in terms of *word formation, word meaning and word use*.

The study is divided into four chapters. The **first chapter** consists of the background of the study, importance of textbook analysis, vocabulary, review of the related literature, objectives, process of the data collection, and limitations of the study. The **second chapter** deals with methodology adopted in carrying out the research. It contains the sources of the data, sampling procedure, tools for data collection, process of data collection and limitation of the study. The **chapter three** consists of analysis, interpretation and tabulation of the data. The data was collected through questionnaire and a test and analyzed. The **chapter four** incorporates the major findings of the study on the basis of analysis and interpretation of the data. It also deals with some recommendations made on the basis of findings of study.
