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#### ABSTRACT

The thesis entitled "Perception of Teachers and Students towards the Influence of Mother Tongue in ELT Classroom" is an attempt to find out teachers as well as students' perception towards their mother tongue use in second language classroom. I collected the data by distributing the questionnaire to altogether 80 students and 10 teachers of higher secondary schools of public and private. They were from different ten (five public based and 5 private) higher secondary schools of Dhanusha district. The data were analysed in order to find out their perspectives toward different options. The major findings of the study shows that mother tongue use in ELT classroom is perceived positive by both students and teachers. It is recommended that teachers are required to get training regarding creating the English environment into the classroom.

There are four chapters: the first of which deals with general background, the concept of perception, review of related literature, objectives of the study and the significance of the study. The second chapter deals with methodology. It includes sources of data, population of the study, sampling procedure, tools for data collection, process of data collection and limitations of the study. The chapter three entails analysis and interpretation of the data. It deals with the analysis of collected data and interpretation of them by using different statistical tools, graphs, charts and percentage. Likewise, the four chapter incorporates findings and recommendations.
