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ABSTRACT

This research study entitled "The Need of English for Home-Makers" aims to explore and identify the necessity of the English language for the home-makers. This study tries to find out how much important the possession of English for home-makers. It also tries to throw light on the particular works in comparison to others for which the necessity of English always strikes. All the data were collected through questionnaire. For the primary source of data I selected 40 home-makers from Kirtipur in Kathmandu. Purposive non-random sampling was used as sampling procedure in this study. To complete this study I have used related books, journals, articles, magazines as secondary sources of data. This study shows that the homemakers need English in almost all of the situations or in their works.
