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Abstract

This research is an exploration of the exploitation of political irony in the novel *The Tiger Claw* by Shauna Singh Baldwin. I have come to the conclusion that *The Tiger Claw* involves irony in it as a tool to ironize the patriarchal coercion and hegemony. Therefore, it deals with the irrelevance of phallogocentrism and aims at displacing it by feminist ethos.
