

ABSTRACT

This thesis entitled "Content Validity of General English test items at B.Ed. level "A Case of reading and writing" attempts to determine whether the reading and writing test items have content validity or not.

The main objective of this research study was to analyze the content validity of reading and writing test items at B.Ed. level. In order to fulfill this purpose, the researcher analyzed five years question papers from 2059 to 2063 B.S. of reading and writing. Only the secondary sources of data were used for this purpose. The test contents were compared and analysis was done with course contents in terms of coverage and weightage. It was found that "Reading and Writing" test items have low content validity in terms of content coverage and have high content validity in terms of course content weightage. This study is divided into four chapters.

The first chapter deals with the introduction which consists of general background (Language teaching and language testing, an introduction to test, types of tests, functions and purposes of test, requirements of a good test, introduction to General English at B.Ed. level, the syllabus of General English, general information of the course book, and four basic language skills). It also includes review of the literature, objectives of the study and significance of the study.

The second chapter is related to the methodology which consists of sources of data, tools for data collection, process of data collection and limitation of the study.

The third chapter deals with the analysis and interpretation of the collected data which have been analyzed and interpreted in terms of coverage and weightage in order to find out content validity of the related test.

The last chapter deals with the findings, recommendations and pedagogical implications of the study. These findings have been outlined on the basis of the analysis and interpretation of data and appropriate recommendations and pedagogical implications have been made.
