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### **ABSTRACT**

This thesis entitled 'Pronominals in the English and Magar Language: A Linguistic comparative study' endeavours to compare and contrast pronominal systems of the English and Magar languages. The researcher collected data from both primary and secondary sources. The native speakers of the Magar language are the primary sources of the data and the different books, journals, magazines and theses are the secondary sources of data. This research has been based on the informants above 15 years of age. Among the informants, 30 were educated, other 30 were literate and the rest of 30 were illiterate. The researcher used the stratified random sampling procedure to sample the population. The interview was used as a research tool for data collection. With the help of analysis and interpretation of the data provided by the informants, findings were drawn which are: the Magar language has more number of pronouns in comparison to English; they are eight and they are more complex than those of English.
